Schedule A: Practice and Professional Development

1. The requirements to maintain eligibility, as an active member shall be as outlined in Bylaw II, Section 3.
2. All medical radiation technologists shall have five (5) years to obtain the practice hours as determined by the Association to complete the continuing education credits in accordance with the Continuing Education Program to maintain their eligibility to practice.
3. Casual and Part time Medical Radiation technologists are required to maintain the same practice hours and continuing education requirements as full time medical radiation technologists.
4. The following policies shall be applied for the assessment of practice hours:
 - (a) Annual paid hours shall be used to calculate the practice hours. Overtime and callback hours are also eligible (i.e. the number of hours actually worked).
 - (b) Volunteer hours obtained in the practice of medical radiation technology may be used to achieve the required number of practice hours. Volunteer hours must be documented on the appropriate form and evaluated by the Credentials Committee.

- (c) All hours worked by Medical Radiation Technologists in Management shall be credited toward eligible practice hours.
- (d) All hours worked by Medical Radiation Technologists in veterinary facilities shall be credited toward eligible practice hours.
- (e) All hours worked by Medical Radiation Technologists in medical research facilities shall be credited toward eligible practice hours.
- (f) All hours worked by Medical Radiation Technologists on medical radiation information and picture archive and communication systems shall be credited toward eligible practice hours.
- (g) All hours worked by Medical Radiation Technologists as a Radiation Safety Officer shall be credited toward eligible practice hours.
